On July 15, 2015, Administrative Order No. C-15-015-026-ETT was issued by the Louisiana Department of Health (LDH) to Town of Plain Dealing Water System for exceeding Maximum Contaminant Level for total trihalomethanes (TTHMs), failure to monitor for TTHMs and HAA5, failure to submit Operational Evaluation Level reports for TTHMs, failure to monitor for chlorine residuals, failure to issue public notice for exceeding Secondary Maximum Contaminant Level for Fluoride, and failure to correct significant deficiencies within Town of Plain Dealing Water System.

LDH finds that Town of Plain Dealing Water System has complied with all ordered remedial action items of Administrative Order No. C-15-015-026-ETT. By notice of this letter, the State Health Officer hereby terminates Administrative Order No. C-15-015-026-ETT.
