WHEREAS, the Town of Plain Dealing has been awarded a FY 2024 Louisiana Community Development Block  
Grant (LCDBG) for Sewer Improvements;

WHEREAS, the LCDBG Program requires the adoption of plans and policies, appointments, and authorization  
of individuals for compliance with the LCDBG regulations;

WHEREAS, it is necessary under the regulations of the LCDBG Program to authorize certain individuals to sign  
for Request for Payment for LCDBG funds, designate an official depository to hold LCDBG funds, and authorize  
certain individuals to sign checks on the official depository;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following appointments and authorization of individuals are made; (1)  
Handicapped/Section 504 Compliance/Coordinator – Rolandria McCauley (2) Antidisplacement Coordinator –  
Rolandria McCauley, (3) Equal Employment Officer – Rolandria McCauley, (4) Citizen Complaint Officer –  
Rolandria McCauley, (5) Labor Compliance Officer - LCDBG Administrator, and (6) Authorize the Mayor to sign  
all documents pertaining to the LCDBG Program;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, James Cook and Rolandria McCauley are hereby authorized to sign for  
Requests for Payment, that Bonvenu Bank is hereby designated as the official depository of all LCDBG funds  
and that James Cook, Rolandria McCauley, and Jeffery Benson are authorized to sign checks on the official  
depository, of which two signatures are required for each check.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution and the above referenced adoptions and appointments  
supersede any and all previous adoptions pertaining to the aforementioned items.
